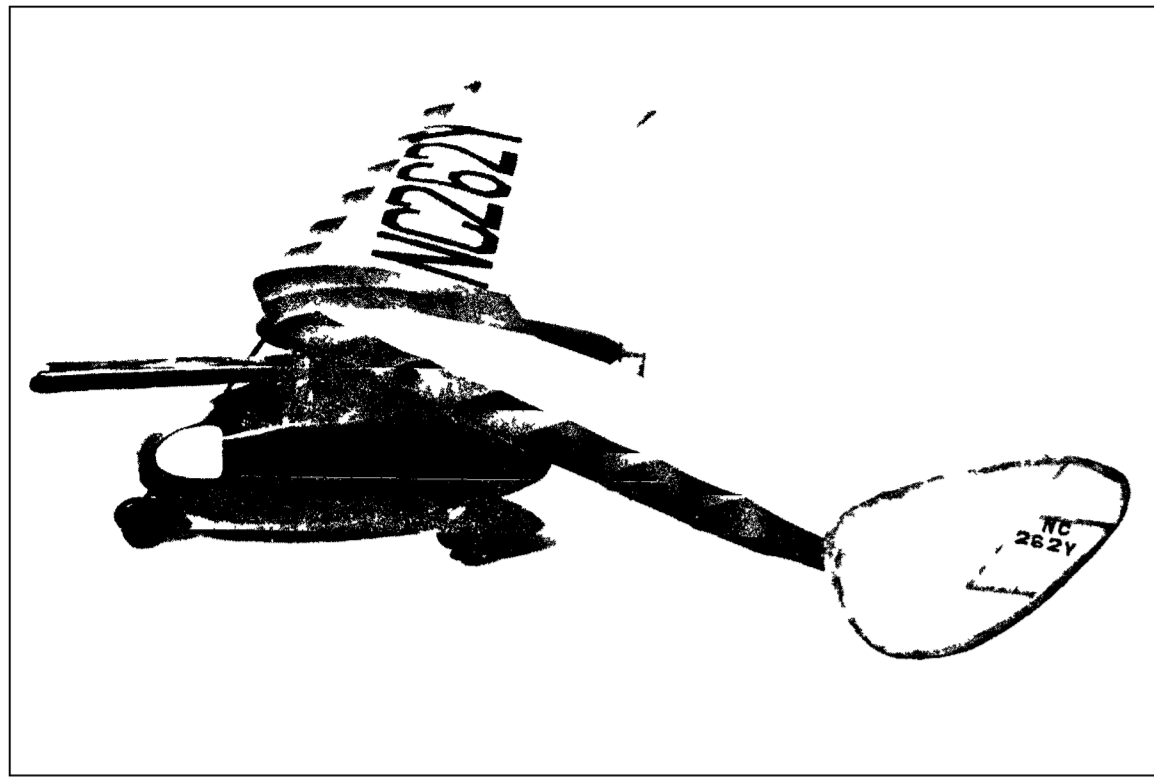


COVERING NOTES

COVER ALL PARTS WITH GRAIN OF PAPER RUNNING LENGTHWISE, WATCHING OUT FOR WRINKLES. ON ROUNDED SURFACES, COVER ONE SECTION AT A TIME, USING SMALL PIECES OF TISSUE PAPER. THE WING IS COVERED, USING A SEPARATE PIECE OF TISSUE FOR THE TOP AND BOTTOM OF EACH WING PANEL.

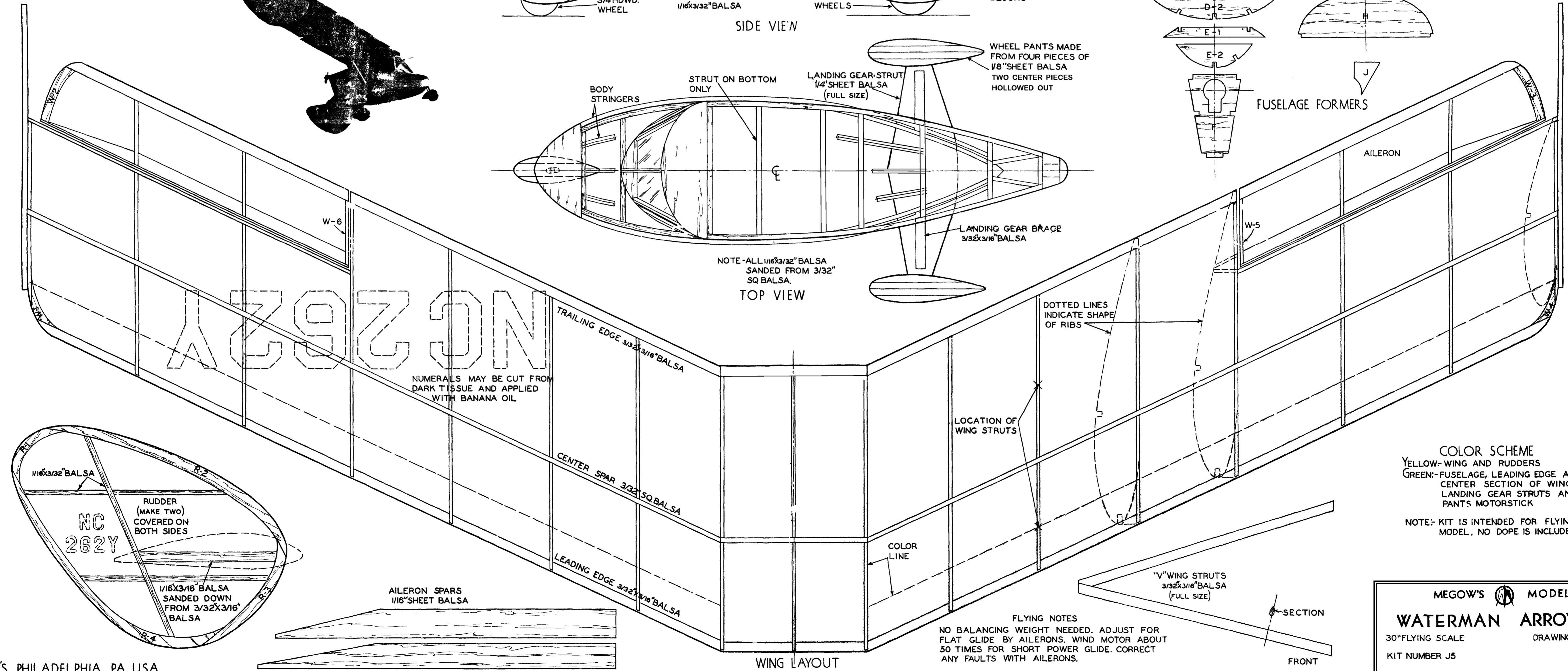
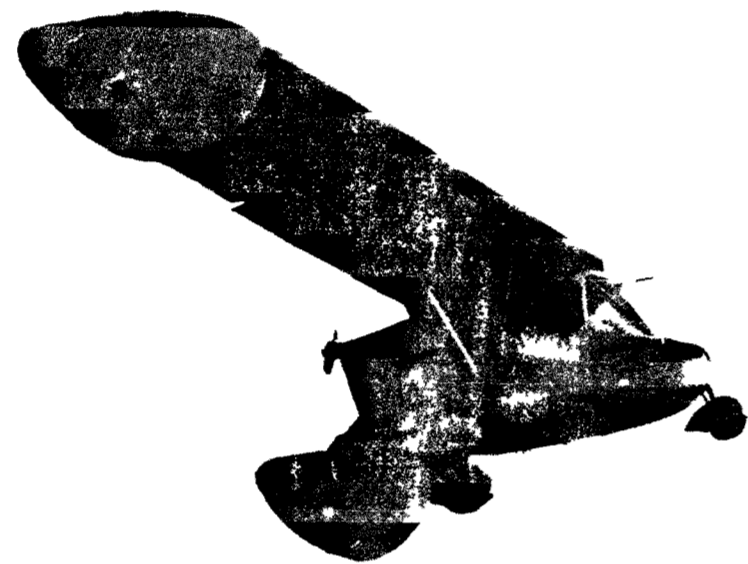
NOTE-PROP SHAFT AND REAR HOOK, BENT FROM WIRE FURNISHED IN KIT



CONSTRUCTION NOTES

CONSTRUCT FUSELAGE FIRST, BEGINNING WITH TWO SIDES. MAKE SQUARE FRAMEWORK, ADD ON ALL FORMERS, THEN PUT ON NOSE, REAR BLOCKS AND STRINGERS. CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN IN CONSTRUCTING THE FUSELAGE, AS IT IS A BIT TRICKY, BUT SIMPLE IF THE PLAN IS FIRST STUDIED CAREFULLY. BUILD THE WING AND RUDDERS ACCORDING TO THE PLAN, USING PARTS FROM THE PRINTED PIECE. START WITH THE WING OUTLINE FIRST, AND WHILE THAT IS DRYING, CUT OUT THE RIBS FROM THE PRINT-

ED PIECE. WHEN THE OUTLINE IS DRY RAISE IT UP, ON THE PINS THAT FASTENED IT DOWN TO THE PLAN, TO THE PROPER HEIGHT AND SLIP IN THE RIBS. WHEN THE WING IS DRY, PUT IN THE PROPER AMOUNT OF DIHEDRAL AND CEMENT IN THE TOP CENTER SPAR COVER ALL PARTS SEPARATELY BEFORE ASSEMBLING MODEL.
